IMPORTANT MAY CASCADE FARM TRIAL INFORMATION

Due to the wet spring we have had they just finished repair work on the field. We are sorry for the inconvenience this will cause. We did not want to cancel the trial and hope you will work with us to get through the weekend. The whole field is our hay field which we use to feed our sheep through the winter. The less we trample the better for our sheep. There is standing water on many parts of the field including the trial field. We look forward to seeing you in a few days.

DRIVEWAY: Our driveway is a bit rough from all the truck traffic delivering stone to repair the damage from the flood last October.

NEW ROAD: There is a **new road of crushed stone** through the field. Stay on the road until you get to the camping and parking areas. Even with standing water on the road you will not bog down or get stuck.

CAMPING & PARKING: Parking and camping this year is different due to the flood damage we had last October. There will be flagged off areas of dirt. Do not park, camp or drive there, you will get stuck. The parking and camping areas are **much smaller** than normal and you will need to park and camp closer to each other (like Cummington). We have grazed the parking and camping areas to help you see them easier.

PARKING will be to the right (south) of the tent along the trees from the water wagon to just behind the tent. You can also park facing the trial field along the flex-net.

CAMPING will be to the left (north) of the tent along the pine trees. Smaller campers and RV's should park on the right towards the tent. Longer campers should park to the left (north) side of the road. There is a sandy area that looks like dirt that won't be flagged off. It is safe to camp there.

WEATHER: Rain is predicted for Friday, Friday night, as well as on Sunday.

RIVER: The River is still high with a strong current. Most of the stone beach is underwater. Keep an eye on your dogs and stay away from the river if they are not used to moving water.

POT-LUCK: If the weather predictions for Saturday still call for dry and sunny we will have a pot-luck under the tent around 6:30.
