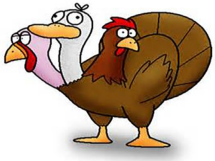
COVID WAIVER

Handler/Attendee: CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) WARNING: The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. The state of medical knowledge is evolving, but the virus is believed to spread from person-to-person contact and/or by contact with contaminated surfaces and objects, and through the air. It is not possible to prevent against the presence of the disease. Therefore, if you choose to attend the Trial you may be exposing yourself to and/or increasing your risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand the hazards of COVID-19 and am familiar with the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) guidelines regarding COVID-19. I acknowledge and understand that the circumstances regarding COVID-19 are changing from day to day and that, accordingly, the CDC guidelines are regularly modified and updated and I accept full responsibility for familiarizing myself with the most recent updates. I have read and understood the above warning concerning COVID-19. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Trial may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Released Parties. If you do not feel SAFE to travel, please do not come. We would rather see you healthy and well at a future event. Below are stipulations for this trial in reference to Covid interim rules USBCHA has imposed. All trials will be sanctioned with USBCHA and Texas Sheepdog Association (in Case you decide you want to go to their finals next fall...become a member) and pending USBCHA Sanctioning.

Open will be held in the big field Friday-Saturday. All classes will run on range stock provided by Auza family, except Ranch and Novice Sunday on Home Field on Yearling Farm Flock.

We will communicate with handlers starting October 16, again on the last day to withdraw and from that point forward only as needed. Run Orders will be posted 72 hours before the trial. No refunds will be issued after October 23, unless any handler that has any symptoms consistent with, or believes that they may have contracted Covid 19, or been exposed to Covid 19. For all classes the pen will be a three sided pen. Scores will not be posted until the end of the day. Scores may be available online depending on access. Shade will not be provided, so bring your own private shade. Please observe social distancing requirements. Masks may be worn at your discretion. We will have some PJ's available for use. If your worried about using them...don't! Plan accordingly. I will not be propping doors open, as I am liable for damage to these units. I will provide access to hand sanitizer (use Sanely). There will be hand washing options, please use them. If you want to rent your own PJ, include a separate check for \$120 for the weekend. Your name will be placed on that unit. Handicap PJ will be available for those who are spectating only, which is not encouraged unless family. Handlers utilize the others, which will be spaced apart. Public restrooms are available at the TA Truck Stop, appx 2 miles from the trial facility.

Meals: We will be offering catered meals for sale during the trial. Breakfast and Lunch meals will be sold at \$10.00 each. Meals will be made and packaged for you specifically. Meals for all trials day will be \$60/ person. (3 Breakfast/3 Lunches). Further information will be sent to you once the entries have closed.

Thursday starting at Noon will be the Gobble Bobble Arena Trial. Yearling farm flock will be used for this event. This will be a judge trial, separate entry form. Otherwise hope to see you all soon.
