From the north and west –

Route 20 south towards Scottsville, Virginia.

Turn right on Route 626, Langhorne Road

At 4-way intersection at Route 6, cross Route 6 continuing south on Langhorne Road

At T-intersection with James River Road, bear right on James River Road, Lone Oak 1 mile on right. Large sign.

From south and east –

Leave Scottsville heading west on Route 6.

Turn left (south) on Langhorne Road, Route 626

At T-intersection with James River Road, bear right on James River Road, Lone Oak 1 mile on right. Large sign.
